

Terms & Conditions – Karnataka Darshana

While every itinerary is thoughtfully planned in advance, minor changes may occasionally be required to ensure the comfort, safety, or overall experience of travellers. In wildlife-based programs, itinerary adjustments may also be necessary to enhance the possibility of wildlife sightings. Guests are kindly requested to cooperate and accept such changes gracefully.

Our programs are designed around destinations where wildlife is known to exist. However, since the animals are wild and free-roaming, their movement and behaviour cannot be predicted or guaranteed. We do not interfere with or manipulate their natural routines in any manner.

Wildlife sightings during the trip are entirely governed by chance, and no claims can be made regarding the presence or visibility of animals.

We make every effort to engage reliable contractors and service providers for transportation, accommodation, guides, and other travel-related services. However, we do not assume direct or indirect responsibility for any loss, damage, injury, delay, or inconvenience to persons or property arising from the services provided by third parties.

Each traveller agrees not to hold the tour operator, its owners, employees, agents, or representatives liable for any loss, injury, damage, or expense resulting directly or indirectly from the acts, omissions, or negligence of any individual or organization providing services in connection with the trip.

We shall not be held responsible for circumstances beyond our control, including but not limited to natural calamities, Acts of God, adverse weather conditions, strikes, theft, political disturbances, military or terrorist activities, government restrictions, or delays or failures of transport systems.

The tour operator reserves the right to revise program fees with little or no prior notice. In such cases, refunds, if any, will be governed strictly by the cancellation policy. We shall not be liable for any additional expenses incurred due to such changes.

As these trips involve travel to natural and wildlife-rich areas, all travellers must strictly adhere to the rules and regulations set by local authorities, guides, and program leaders. Any violation may result in removal from the activity or denial of entry by forest or local authorities.

We reserve the sole right to prohibit any traveller from continuing with a safari, activity, or journey if their behaviour is deemed unsafe, disruptive, or harmful to fellow travellers or wildlife.

Prior to booking confirmation, travellers are required to agree to these terms and conditions. Payment of any advance or token amount signifies acceptance and agreement to be bound by the same.
